OFFICIAL RACE RULES

- \$25 entry fee per craft/boat, made payable to Crime Stoppers of York County.
- Check In, 11:00 11:45am, Craft sign-in and safety inspections begin
- Prizes will be awarded to the top two (2) youth and adult racers based on fastest time and that the craft is still afloat. Ribbons will also be given for Best Dressed and Decorated in each category.
- The race will begin promptly at noon.
- No alcohol
- Innertubes may be used to build the crafts, but crafts made only of innertubes will not be permitted.
- Late arrivals may be disqualified.
- The craft must not be loaded with passengers and cargo beyond its safe carrying capacity.
- Each person must always be wearing an approved personal floatation device (PFD). The life vest must be in excellent condition and must fit the participant appropriately.
- No horseplay by participants which may be harmful to crafts or surrounding individuals.
- No fireworks.
- All crafts must be removed no later than one hour after the completion of the race.
- No motorized crafts of any kind.
- All participants must stay aboard craft for the duration of the race, if any crew members fall or jump into the water, the craft will be disqualified.
- All participants must sign legal release form to compete in the event.
- Decisions of the race committee are final without appeal of matters concerning the race.
- Race officials are empowered to decide at their discretion any cases not covered by existing rules.
- Participants under the age of eighteen (18) must have a parent/guardian signature on release form. Race committee may request proof of age documention to confirm consent requirement.
